Event Location

- Dirksen Senate Building, Room 106, Washington D.C. 20002
 - Located on the corner of 1st Street and Constitution Ave NE



Hotels

- Within a radius of 5 miles of Capitol Hill the average price is \$300 per night.
- Within a radius of 10 miles the average price is \$150 to \$200 per night.
- Within a radius of 15 miles the average price is \$100 to \$120 per night.

The closer the hotel is to Capitol Hill, the more expensive it will be.

Transportation

- **Metro:** When staying outside the city, the Metro is the easiest way to get into D.C. and provides access to Capitol Hill. (Map included on following page).
 - Capitol South Metro Station is ½ mile (about a 10 minute walk) from the event location and is accessible from the **Orange**, **Blue**, and **Silver** lines.
- **Uber:** While in the city, Uber is a great way to travel.

Parking

- **Metered Parking:** Metered parking is available everywhere throughout the D.C. area. Prices range from 70¢ to \$1.00 per hour.
- **Parking Garages:** Various parking garages or lots are scattered throughout the area by the hour or day. Average daily parking prices are \$15.

Airports

- **Ronald Reagan:** Reagan is about 5 miles from the event location and, due to the short distance, will be about \$100 to \$200 more than other options.
- **Baltimore-Washington International:** BWI is about 30 miles from the event location and is cheaper than Reagan.
- **Dulles International:** Dulles is about 30 miles from the event location and is the largest and cheapest option.

The closer the airport is to Capitol Hill, the more expensive it will be.
